FAITH INTERNATIONAL UNIVERSITY

As a graduate of at least 1 year of V1 College, Students will be prepared to take the Comprehensive Bible Exam at FIU which allows students to earn up to 30 credits; 33% credit hour scholarship; when enrolled. An articulation agreement can provide a pathway for students to complete a formal degree by reviewing course equivalency and the possibility of transfer credits to FIU in accordance with the FIU's transfer policy.

Statement of Faith

The human phraseology employed in this statement is not inspired nor contended for, but the truth set forth is held to be essential to a full Gospel ministry. No claim is made that it contains all the truth in the Bible, only that it covers orthodox fundamental matters.

Holy Bible

The Holy Bible, and only the Bible, is the authoritative Word of God. It alone is the final authority in determining all doctrinal truths. In its original writing, it is inspired, infallible and inerrant (2Timothy 3:16; 2 Peter 1:20-21; Proverbs 30:5; Romans 16:25-26).

Trinity

There is one God, eternally existent in three persons: Father, Son and Holy Spirit. These three are co-equal and co-eternal (I John 5:7; Genesis 1:26; Matthew 3:16-17, 28:19; Luke 1:35; Isaiah 9:6; Hebrews 3:7-11).

Jesus Christ

Jesus Christ is God the Son, the second person of the Trinity. On earth, Jesus was 100% God and 100% man. He is the only man ever to have lived a sinless life. He was born of a virgin, lived a sinless life, performed miracles, died on the cross for mankind and thus, atoned for our sins through the shedding of His blood. He rose from the dead on the third day according to the Scriptures, ascended to the right hand of the Father, and will return again in power and glory (John 1:1,14, 20:28; 1Timothy 3:16; Isaiah 9:6; Philippians 2:5-6; 1Timothy 2:5).

Virgin Birth

Jesus Christ was conceived by God the Father, through the Holy Spirit (the third person of the Trinity) in the virgin Mary's womb; therefore, He is the Son of God (Matthew 1:18, 25; Luke 1:35; Isaiah 7:14; Matthew 1:18, 23-25; Luke 1:27-35). 05

Redemption

Man was created good and upright, but by voluntary transgression he fell; his only hope of redemption is in Jesus Christ, the Son of God (Gen.1:26-31, 3:1-7; Romans 5:12-21).

Regeneration

For anyone to know God, regeneration by the Holy Spirit is absolutely essential (John 6:44, 65).

Salvation

We are saved by grace through faith in Jesus Christ; His death, burial, and resurrection. Salvation is a gift from God, not a result of our good works or of any human efforts (Ephesians 2:8-9; Galatians 2:16, 3:8; Titus 3:5; Romans 10:9-10; Acts 16:31; Hebrews 9:22).

Repentance

Repentance is the commitment to turn away from sin in every area of our lives and to follow Christ, which allows us to receive His redemption and to be regenerated by the Holy Spirit. Thus, through repentance we receive forgiveness of sins and appropriate salvation (Acts 2:21, 3:19; 1 John 1:9).

Sanctification

Sanctification is the ongoing process of yielding to God's Word and His Spirit in order to complete the development of Christ's character in us. It is through the present ministry of the Holy Spirit and the Word of God that the Christian is enabled to live a godly life (1Thessalonians 4:3, 5:23; 2 Corinthians 3:18, 6:14-18, 2 Thessalonians 2:1-3, Romans 8:29, 12:1-2, Hebrews 2:11).

Jesus' Blood

The Blood that Jesus Christ shed on the Cross of Calvary was sinless and is 100% sufficient to cleanse mankind of all sin. Jesus allowed Himself to be punished for both our sinfulness and our sins, enabling all those who believe to be free from the penalty of sin, which is death (1 John 1:7; Revelation 1:5, 5:9; Colossians 1:20; Romans 3:10-12, 23, 5:9; John 1:29)

Jesus Christ Indwells All Believers

Christians are people who have invited the Lord Jesus Christ to come and live inside them by His Holy Spirit. They relinquish the authority of their lives over to him thus making Jesus the Lord of their life as well as Savior. They put their trust in what Jesus accomplished for them when He died, was buried, and rose again from the dead (John 1:12; John 14:17, 23; John 15:4; Romans 8:11; Revelations 3:20).

Baptism in the Holy Spirit

Given at Pentecost, it is the promise of the Father, sent by Jesus after His Ascension, to empower the church to preach the Gospel throughout the whole earth (Joel 2:28-29; Matthew 3:11; Mark 16:17; Acts 1:5, 2:1-4, 17, 38-39, 8:14-17, 10:38, 44-47, 11:15-17, 19:1-6).

The Gifts of the Holy Spirit

The Holy Spirit is manifested through a variety of spiritual gifts to build and sanctify the church, demonstrate the validity of the resurrection, and confirm the power of the Gospel. The Bible lists of these gifts are not necessarily exhaustive, and the gifts may occur in various combinations.
All believers are commanded to earnestly desire the manifestation of the gifts in their lives. These gifts always operate in harmony with the Scriptures and should never be used in violation of Biblical parameters (Hebrews 2:4; Romans 1:11, 12 : 4-8; Ephesians 4:16; 2 Timothy 1:5-16, 4:14; 1 Corinthians 12:1-31, 14:1-40; 1 Peter 4:10).

The Church

The church is the Body of Christ, the habitation of God through the Spirit, with divine appointments for the fulfillment of Jesus' great commission. Every person who is born of the Spirit is an integral part of the church as a member of the body of believers. There is a spiritual unity of all believers in our Lord Jesus Christ (Ephesians 1:22, 2:19-22; Hebrews 12:23; John 17:11, 20-23).

Healing of the Sick

Healing of the sick is illustrated in the life and ministry of Jesus, and included in the commission of Jesus to His disciples. It is given as a sign which is to follow believers. It is also a part of Jesus' work on the Cross and one of the gifts of the Spirit (Psalm 103:2-3; Isaiah 53:5; Matthew 8:16-17; Mark 16:17-18; Acts 8:6-7; James 5:14-16; 1 Corinthians 12:9, 28; Romans 11:29).

God's Will for Provision

It is the Father's will for believers to become whole, healthy and successful in all areas of life. But because of the fall, many may not receive the full benefits of God's will while on Earth. That fact, though, should never prevent all believers from seeking the full benefits of Christ's provision in order to better serve others.

- 1. Spiritual (John 3:3-11; 2 Corinthians 5:17-21; Romans 10:9-10).
- Mental and Emotional (2 Timothy 1:7, 2:11; Philippians 4:7-8; Romans 12:2; Isaiah 26:3).
 Physical (Isaiah 53:4-5; Matthew 8:17; 1 Peter 2:24).
- 3. Financial (Joshua 1:8; Malachi 3:10-11; Luke 6:38; 2 Corinthians 9:6-10; Deuteronomy 28:1-14; Psalm 34:10, 84:11; Philippians 4:19).

Resurrection

Jesus Christ was physically resurrected from the dead in a glorified body three days after His death on the cross. In addition, both the saved and the lost will be resurrected; they that are saved to the resurrection of life and they that are lost to the resurrection of eternal damnation (Luke 24:16, 36, 39; John 2:19-21, 20:26-28, 21:4; Acts 24:15; 1 Corinthians 15:42, 44; Philippians 1:21-23, 3:21).

Heaven

Heaven is the eternal dwelling place for all believers in the Gospel of Jesus Christ (Matthew 5:3, 12, 20, 6:20, 19:21, 25:34; John 17:24; 2 Corinthians 5:1; Hebrews 11:16; 1 Peter 1:4).

Hell

After living one life on earth, the unbelievers will be judged by God and sent to Hell where they will be eternally tormented with the Devil and the Fallen Angels (Matthew 25:41; Mark 9:43-48; Hebrews 9:27; Revelation 14:9-11, 20:12-15, 21:8).

Second Coming

Jesus Christ will physically and visibly return to earth for the second time to establish His Kingdom. This will occur at a date undisclosed by the Scriptures (Matthew 24:30, 26:63-64; Acts 1:9-11; 1 Thessalonians 4:15-17; 2 Thessalonians 1:7-8; Revelation 1:7).

Water Baptism

Following faith in the Lord Jesus Christ, the new convert is commanded by the Word of God to be baptized in water in the Name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit (Matthew 28:19; Acts 2:38).

The Lord's Supper

A unique time of communion in the presence of God when the elements of bread and grape juice (the Body and Blood of the Lord Jesus Christ) are taken in remembrance of Jesus' sacrifice on the Cross (Matthew 26:26-29; Mark 16:16; Acts 8:12, 36-38; 10:47-48; 1 Corinthians 10:16, 11:23-25).

Foot Washing

The ordinance of shall be observed as seen fit by all established places of worship, as enjoined in the Scriptures (John 13:1-17; Luke 7:36-50).

About Our Mentorship Program



At V1 College we believe that every student desires to become what they're created for. Every advanced student who enrolls in our mentorship program will receive personal and spiritual development, accountability, increased awareness of your gifts, practical tools, and organizational support.



Mentorship at V1 College is not a substitute for personal counseling or replaces the model of spiritual authority. We supplement what has already been provided with an emphasis on Gospel-centered teaching and training through group settings.

What Is Mentorship?



Our S.M.G (Student Mentorship Groups) facilitates a learning environment that promotes spiritual formation, accountability for the development and deployment of each student.

You will meet with your mentors at the designated times of the group either in-person or online. Since you will be placed with others from around the world, it's an opportunity to grow alongside your fellow students collectively, encouraging one another and seeing them get to graduation. Think about it as a family doing life together. Mentorship is not just one-to-one but happens in circles. It's the model that Jesus demonstrated to us through his disciples who turned the world upside down.

The Mentoring Relationship

What you have learned and received and heard and seen in me—practice these things, and the God of peace will be with you. - Philippians 4:9

The student group leader is a facilitator of the teaching and vision of V1 College. Groups will be conducted during our global seminars in breakout rooms for one hour. Active listening and engagement through prayer and encouragement are part of the relationship process. Your mentor will always provide you with other opportunities to meet throughout the program through Zoom, in-person gatherings, and hosted events at V1 College. It's vital for you to have constant communication with your mentor during your study. This is imperative so you can get the most out of your mentorship.



The Mentorship Expectations

Challenge

An Advance Student is expected to build relationships with their mentor. Following up with phone calls, instructions, and meetings are part of the curriculum

Benefit

Accountability, encouragement, focus, and redirection are just a few of the things that an advanced student will learn from their mentorship program.

Church Involment

Each student participates within their role and function in the local church setting. That means being active in services, and events as needed by the designated church staff.

Community Involvement

Each student is to take what they've learned from the lectures and mentorship and give it back to the community. This is becoming the hands and feet of Jesus.

Leadership

Each advanced student will be expected to lead either a dream team, connect group, or function in a leadership capacity during the halfway mark of their program.



POLICIES & PROCEDURES

The things we believe in that help make our college extraordinary for the kingdom

THE WORD

The Bible is the authoritative, infallible Word of God and is the foundational guide for study and reason. An individual's right to study and reason is a fundamental, protected freedom. However, there are limitations on such freedom. Limits arise when the values and morals of society are in opposition to the beliefs and values of the institution.

THE STUDENT

Academic freedom does not restrain an individual's right to question but instead encourages intellectual debate without fear of censorship and retaliation. These conversations are done with respect and in a safe place within the confines of V1 College through our global seminars, facebook group or coffee with the dean sessions.

DISMISSAL POLICY

At V1 College, students may face dismissal from their programs at any time during their course of study if they fail to uphold Christlike character to a high standard. Dismissal may result from violations against state or local law that negatively impact their relationship with the college, unrepented personal sins, or refusal to reconcile with God. Enrollment is contingent upon adherence to the rules and character outlined in scripture. Additionally, students must be active in a local church, serving, and participating in church activities; absence or lack of participation can lead to dismissal or downgrading from the Advanced program. Finally, failure to make prompt tuition payments may result in a delay or dismissal from the college.

REFUND POLICY

V1 College has a refund policy that conforms to most colleges. Generally speaking, students who drop out of the program during the College's official drop/refund period may be entitled to a partial refund of their tuition. The date the program is dropped will determine the percentage of tuition and fees refunded.

The percentage of tuition and fees refunded is ONLY for those who have made a FULL payment:

100% - prior to the first day of the semester
75% - during the first week of classes
50% - during the second week of classes
25% - during the third week of classes

0% - after the fourth week of classes

Note: You must also provide a reason for your refund that will be determined if it qualifies for refund status.





ENROLLMENT ADMISSIONS

Enrollment at V1 College is simple! Just visit us at https://v1college.com/sign-up/ and choose which program you are interested in. Once your payment is received, you will get a follow-up email with more instructions and your login credentials before the start of the semester.

Once you are accepted into the program, you will need to fill out an admission application. This will help us to provide you with the best experience at V1 College.

The deadline to enroll in the upcoming academic year is August 25, 2024.

V1 COLLEGE YEAR 2
